SUBJECT: EXTENSION OF COVID-19 FORECLOSURE MORATORIUM

This Guide Bulletin announces an extension of the COVID-19 foreclosure moratorium.

EFFECTIVE DATE

All of the changes announced in this Bulletin are effective immediately unless otherwise noted.

EXTENSION OF THE COVID-19 FORECLOSURE MORATORIUM

We are extending the foreclosure moratorium announced in Guide Bulletins 2020-4, 2020-10, 2020-16, 2020-25, 2020-34 and 2020-46. Servicers must suspend all foreclosure actions, including foreclosure sales, through **February 28, 2021**. This includes initiation of any judicial or non-judicial foreclosure process, move for foreclosure judgment or order of sale. This foreclosure suspension does not apply to Mortgages on properties that have been determined to be vacant or abandoned.
